Dear Resident and Family Member,

On June 8 and June 9, 2020, Valley View Retirement Community completed universal testing of Haven residents and team members. Approximately 329 residents and team members were tested for COVID-19. Results have come in with **100% of residents testing negative and only 1 team member testing positive for COVID-19.**

The team member last worked on June 10, 2020 and was not symptomatic while working. Like all team members working at Valley View, this team member went through a screening process, including having their temperature taken in accordance with Pennsylvania Department of Health (DOH) guidelines. S/he also followed guidelines for personal protective equipment while working. Given the nature of their role, the risk of transmission to others is low. The impacted team member is currently self-quarantined at home until s/he is cleared to return to work.

Valley View is committed to being transparent in keeping residents, families, and team members aware of changes related to COVID-19. Residents and their responsible parties as well as team members who have been in direct contact with this team member are being notified. All those will be closely monitored for symptoms with targeted retesting occurring this week.

On June 10, 2020, Department of Health completed an on-site assessment of our efforts related to infection control prevention and COVID-19 measures. They found no deficient practice. Valley View has followed and will continue to follow the guidance and notifications set forth by DOH, Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC), and Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS) to minimize the risk of Coronavirus transmission within our community.

We thank you for your continued prayers and patience during this unprecedented time.
